
The Week's Highlights

December PCE (Personal Consumption Expenditure) report came in nearly level with consensus; headline read of 0.17% (0.2% consensus), up from last month's 0.07% decline. Annualized PCE lowest since February 2021 at 2.60%, just below November's 2.64% print. Core PCE (the Fed's preferred inflation measure) of 0.17% also in line, up from last month's 0.06% print, while annualized core lowest since March 2021 at 2.9%.

First read for Q4 GDP (Gross Domestic Product) was annualized 3.3% (chart below), below Q3's 4.9% but well ahead of consensus for 2%. Consumer spending a notable driver; strength in both services (particularly food services and accommodations) and goods (pharmaceutical products, software). Q4 chain price at 1.5%. below consensus 2.3% and Q3's 3.3%.

Markit's January services PMI (Purchasing Managers Index) hit 52.9 versus consensus for 51.0 and last month's 51.4. Both input and selling costs rose at a slower pace, while companies reduced workforces at only a marginal pace. Manufacturing PMI returned to expansion at 50.3 versus forecasts for 47.8 and December's 47.9. Aided by improved order inflows. Release noted improved operating conditions at goods producers, first time in 9 months, but also supply chain issues.
